Information Notice About New Collection Containers

The City of Madison will begin rolling out new garbage collection containers by Oct. 1, 2024, as part of the Transfer Station Operations Modernization plan.

The new collection containers will help keep our city clean, safe and beautiful by eliminating trash bags and loose items from the curb and will reduce employee injuries from hazards such as heavy lifting, sharp objects, etc.

Highlights and Features:

Garbage collection containers will be provided by the City at no additional cost and will be delivered directly to your property. Each container will have a bar code identifying the property address.

Your old/non-compatible container will be disposed of by the City.

All containers have a 10 year warranty. Should damage occur outside the warranty, or your container is lost or stolen, a replacement container is available at the property owner's expense.

Changes are not being made to the City recycling program, and you can continue to use your current container.

95-Gallon Cart

Holds 3+ 30-gal bags or 7+ 13-gal kitchen bags



65-Gallon Cart

Holds 2+ 30-gal bags or 5+ 13-gal kitchen bags



35-Gallon Cart

Holds 1+ 30-gal bags or 3+ 13-gal kitchen bags



What size container will I be issued?

Each property owner can decide which container size is best for them. Containers will be available in the following sizes: 95, 65 and 35 gallon.

There will be a short trial period and an opportunity to change your container size if needed.

How do I request my container size?

Visit madison-in.gov/selectmycart or scan the QR code to select your container size.

If you cannot access the site, call the city street department at 812-265-8304 or pick up a form in City Hall, 101 W. Main Street.



The site will be open from now until July 31.

Can I keep my current container?

You may keep your current container if it is garbage truck compatible with a lift bar and is not larger than 96 gallons. However, you must let us know if you plan to keep your container by calling the City Street Department at 812-265-8304. The City will provide you with a sticker to affix to the container.

Can I Request more than one container?

Property owners may request more than one container at an additional cost of \$20 a month per container.
